

Apprentice of the Year Award 2024

Applications close February 28, 2024

The SHRFA wishes to promote excellence in the engineering tradition of Sir Henry Royce by recognizing and annually awarding a current apprentice who demonstrates an outstanding skill-set and attitude and who is currently employed in Australia in the servicing of Rolls-Royce and Bentley products including diesel, aero or commercial engines as well as coachbuilding.

The winner will be announced at the annual Rolls- Royce Owners' Club, Australia in Queensland in May 2024. The award is \$1000 plus name added to the perpetual trophy.

Eligibility Criteria

Nominees must:

- Be employed in Australia in the servicing or restoration of Rolls-Royce or Bentley products. This employment could be in mechanical, electrical, body repairs, maintenance and associated areas.
- Be recognized by the employer as an apprentice with dedication, talent and enthusiasm for the tasks undertaken.
- Demonstrate an ongoing commitment to excellence in the chosen area of automotive or aero servicing or restoration.
- Be supported by references from the employer or TAFE or other relevant training results. This may include a reference from a Recognized Training Authority.
- Provide most recent and highest education results.
- The APPLICANT to provide a 400-word outline of her/his current training with particular reference to his/her experience of and interest in Rolls-Royce or Bentley products.
- The EMPLOYER to complete an outline of the nominee apprentice addressing the following:
 - i. Name, age, place of employment, email
 - ii. Description of work duties
 - iii. Length of time working in current position
 - iv. Previous employment history of the applicant
 - v. The particular skills, attributes and attitudes which support the application.
